FOREWORD

When we observe the mathematical regularity of the movements of the Heavenly Bodies, we are forced to admit that chance, in so harmonious and gigantic a scheme, is an impossible factor. The position, for example, of a planet like Venus, can be accurately determined for the moment desired for ages remote and for ages to come. So it is with all the starry points of Heaven.

The sacred writings state that God knows the end of a thing at the very beginning, and a closer union with the Creator and His Creation will enable us to more truly understand the laws which govern us; a knowledge necessary to enlightenment and true spiritual advancement.

A close study of the Bible, so easily obtained, and kindred magical books, will enable us to pierce the symbolic clouds and open to us a wonderland of exploration which surpasses, by far, all ventures which the progressive and curious mind of man has challenged him to attempt. Miracles will be laid bare to him, and as each miracle is revealed and understood new marvels will greet him and lure him on to greater ones ahead.

In that sacred traditional code of the Hebrews of such value to students, known as the Kabala, the number 20 is symbolized as "the Awakening". (See my book "Numbers and Their Practical Application" obtainable from Messrs. Phipps-Coton, Ltd. of Bolt Court, Fleet Street, London). Twenty is emblematic of the lifting of our negative sleeping selves to the true realization of our positive immortality, to our oneness with the Father whom (as the philosophic Russian poet Derzhavin writes) "none can comprehend and none explain". It is the Wisdom which the Magician King Solomon asked for above all things, for the knowledge of true Wisdom reveals all things.

It is no degradation, as some so termed religious people insist, to apply some of this bountiful Wisdom to the subject of horseracing. Horseracing is a very important industry, providing employment for a large number of people and a vast amount of money. It is as dignified as any other form of speculation, and much more dignified than many which are regarded as respectable.

I have been told that by giving attention to horseracing

from an occult and astrological standpoint, I am lowering my reputation. That my supporters do not generally hold this view is abundantly proven by the great demand for my writings throughout the world. My conscience is clear on that point, and my writings on the subject leave me with no regrets. By this means I am proving the subtle power of religion, and of the Books associated with true religion, in a way that no other form of teaching could show.

ELEMENTARY ASTROLOGY

A knowledge of the signs and symbols of the Heavens is very necessary to the student of the hidden mysteries. As there are many good books devoted to the subject of astrology, the oldest, most helpful and best proven science we know, it is unnecessary to do more than introduce those of my readers (who need the introduction) to the subject so far as it concerns this treatise.

I beg you not to be influenced by the valueless opinions of people who delight to display their ignorance of this vast study, no matter how high sounding their scholastic degrees are in other branches of learning; nor of that section of the Press whose policy is subservient to prejudiced minds.

I am quite aware that much false teaching is foisted on the public, paraded under the name astrology, but whilst the subject is easily enquired into by those who really wish to know the truth, this is no excuse for ignorant ridicule nor intellectual blindness. Arguments are superfluous when evidence is so easily obtainable, for, as the philosopher Stahl writes, "it is stupid to make that a subject of controversy which anyone can prove by experiment".

It was the conceit of many professed scientists in the Victorian era, to place material theories above spiritual facts. Both are essential to our knowledge, and so far as our life conditions are concerned, one is dependent on the other.

In his book, "Music of the Spheres, an almanac for moderns", Mr. Donald Culross Peathe writes:- "Not long ago, the light of the Moon was focussed in a lens of a special telescope to a photo electric cell. Translated into sound, these waves were broadcast to London, and by report, the noise was as tolling of great bells deprived of resonance. Perfect symbol for a world that is dead. When Vega was heard, it was as the high pitched sounding of an angry crowd, but very far away. Vega, one hundred times the size of our Sun. Vega, that incandescent blue giant only 26 light years away spoke to us with the voice of mass menace. So, after all, there is music in the spheres and though it be true that only light translated into sound may be heard, the sound given out by an explosion or a nightingale is also but energy converted into waves that reach us through the ear".

To the student of Steller vibrations, these remarks are of special interest. In my book "Racing and Winning" I introduced to many people a profound discovery which I trust will awaken them to delve deeper and stimulate extended research. I illustrated the LAW (it is not a system, but a definite LAW) for the simpler training of the public mind, by employing Numbers in this elementary work. I now propose to go right into the

original source, and employ factors which existed before the time when maps of the Heavens were constructed to guide our judgments from the position and aspects of the stars. It will suffice, for the purposes of investigation, to know the mere alphabet of this extensive science which deals with all things on earth - minerals, metals, plants, animals and men in its own mysterious and practical manner.

THE PLANETS

The planets are easy to identify if we recognise that their symbols are formed from a cross, a circle and a semi-circle.

The Moon is just a crescent

The Sun a circle with a dot in the centre •

Mercury a cross above a circle, and above, a semi-circle points upwards.

Venus a circle with a cross below

Mars a cross above a circle in modern books

Jupiter a semi-circle above a cross like figure 4

Saturn a cross above a semi-circle 5 in modern books 5

The two more recently discovered planets, not used in my exposition of our subject are:-

Uranus a cross between two semi-circles with a small circle below)+(

Neptune a semi-circle above a cross with a small circle below This planet is given as Neptune's famous trident in modern books.

At present we cannot regard the more recently discovered smaller planets, Pluto included, even though one writer stated that, "Pluto ruled horseracing and indicated the winners",

The ancients had no trouble in securing their wonderful results with the Moon, Sun, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, and our great English Astrologer, William Lilly, employed them with such decisive results as to obtain recognition, not only from the Parliament of Great Britain, but also from foreign rulers.

These planets have their vibrations and are employed in our present study. They are:-

It is the agreement of the vibratory powers which indicate the sensitive factors crystallized in a name sound, and their special sphere of influence is very approximately 4 minutes (one degree of latitude).

The Sun rules	Sunday (SUNday)
The Moon rules	Monday (MOONday)
Mars rules	Tuesday (TEW or MARSday)
Mercury rules	Wednesday (WODEN or Mercury day)
Jupiter rules	Thursday (THOR or Jupiter day)
Venus rules	Friday (FREJA or Venus day)
Saturn rules	Saturday (SATURN'S day)

The Hebrews, in common with the Babylonians and some other ancient nations, counted the first hour of the day from the first hour after noon, and split each hour into 60 minutes, which contained 15 four minute subdivisions. The four minute subdivisions, so important in the law of vibration, are each ruled by one of the planets in this regular order:-

Sun, Venus, Mercury, Moon, Saturn, Jupiter, Mars. The simple division is shown in the following table:-

The daily NOON HOUR (12 a.m. till 1 p.m.) potencies are:-

These tables can be used in any part of the world. When SUMMER TIME is in force, do not forget to deduct one hour, see chapter "Summer Time".

Now suppose we required to find the influences vibrating through the hour, we would proceed as follows:-

Example. Saturday at 2 p.m. As explained in table, this hour is ruled by Jupiter.

Taking the foregoing, the Positive and Negative Divisions sometimes act thus:-

At 12 minutes past 2, the sub period is Venus which is No. 6 and at 40 minutes past 2, the sub period is Venus-Negative, which is set down as No. 3.

But experience shows that this positive-negative theory does not always act in racing events, for a 3 might win in a positive Venus period or a 6 in a negative, and so with all the periods. Practice and observation will solve the difficulty, and practical knowledge will prove an infallible guide.

It MUST be realized that success in so subtle an art is only achieved by studying the matter very critically and very closely. Then your faculties will be sharpened and your deductions will be firmer and reliable.

I had an extremely difficult question to judge by Astrology for a big financial corporation, which involved a very large sum of money. At my first attempt to read the map I had erected for the occasion, I could make nothing of it, and a markedly successful result was only achieved after I had attacked it with determination and concentration.

In this law of vibration, however, the matter is much simpler, but any form of carelessness and lack of observation will lead to errors, and errors may be costly.

THE SIGNS OF THE ZODIAC

The signs of the Zodiac, or indeed any other form of Astrology than that indicated by the planets are not required in dealing with planetary vibrations, but I am introducing some minor suggestions of an interesting nature, and a little Astrological knowledge is necessary to all investigators.

There are 12 signs in the Zodiac, and the Zodiac is the second Astrological alphabet.

These are the old sign rulerships and the only ones used in these studies. The Constellations must not be confused with the signs of the Zodiac whose names they bear, as is done in some almanacs, but as some may desire to experiment with their old number valuations, I now give them:-

Aries, 7: Taurus, 6: Gemini, 12: Cancer, 5: Leo, 1: Virgo, 10: Libra, 8: Scorpio, 9: Sagittarius, 4: Capricorn, 3: Aquarius, 2: Pisces, 11.

THE MIDHEAVEN AND HOW TO FIND IT

A gentleman who is an enthusiastic follower of "The Sport of Kings," told me that he made a considerable sum on the speculative side, by studying suggestions given by me in an old book with reference to the numerical power of the Midheaven at the ADVERTISED time of an event.

Personally, I am convinced that the saddle numbers carried by horses in an event cannot take precedence over the fatalistic vibratory name power which is a fixed and proveable factor. The saddle number is a number of the moment, and in that connection it may serve as a pointer.

There is no doubt that the Midheaven, the point of the Sun at high noon, has a very strong influence over mundane matters, and I have been exercising my mind for some time as how to best employ such a factor in horseracing.

Over 40 years ago I received a translated version by my friend, Comte Macgregor de Glenstrae, of a strange old book by Abra Melin the Mage, as delivered by Abraham the Jew unto his son Lamech, A.D.1458. This unique work was first translated from the original Hebrew into French, thence into English.

The rare manuscript from which the translation was made is in the Bibliotheque de l'Arsenal at Paris, wherein the curious searcher may find at his disposal about a million books and over ten thousand manuscripts.

The Book of Sacred Magic is said to have been received by Divine inspiration "to Moses, Aaron, Solomon and the Saints, patriarchs and prophets, which teacheth the Divine Wisdom".

It is outside the office of this treatise to enlarge upon the occult and magical experiments of Abraham the Jew. What concerns us are his remarks on the Planetary Hours as generally presented.

*Do me the grace:, says Abraham, "to tell me how ye divide the Planetary Hours. I know that ye begin the first hour of the day with the planet which itself giveth the name unto the day as Sunday to the Sun, Monday to the Moon, Tuesday to Mars, Wednesday to Mercury, Thursday to Jupiter, Friday to Venus, and Saturday to Saturn. Then ye divide the length of the day into 12 equal parts which ye call hours and to each ye assign its planet and ye do the same with the night, according to whether the days be long or Thus do the hours become long or short. As for example, on a Sunday the Sun riseth at 7 o'clock and setteth at 5 after noon, 1ts course will be 10 hours (i.e. 7 hours from noon is 5 hours, this plus 5 hours after noon equals 10 hours) the which ye divide into 12 equal parts so that each hour is of 50 minutes length (10 hours equals 600 minutes which divided by I say therefore, that the first planetary hour of 12 gives 50 minutes). the Sun is 50 minutes long: that the second is Venus, the third Mercury and

so on with the other till at last the 8th hour returneth unto the Sun, the 9th Venus, the 10th Mercury and so the day finisheth. Then cometh the night which is longer, that is to say 14 hours, and each Planetary Hour of this night will be 70 minutes and in order to continue the regular succession as we have begun, the first hour of the night will be Jupiter, the second Mars, the third Sun and so on until Monday whose first hour will be (according to this rule) of the Moon. .. Now it is requisite that I should tell unto you what be the Planetary Hours. Know then that each planet hath only one hour during which it is very powerful, being over you and above your head, that is to say on the Meridian.

"There naturally will sometimes arive the Hours of two Planets together and beginning at the same moment they will then produce an effect according unto the nature, quality and complexion of these stars."

So writes the venerable Master, but from repeated experiments I have not been able to confirm his opinion regarding a Midheaven planet's influence over the Hebraic Sunrise Key in racing events.

That a planet in the Midheaven exercises a great power in a person's horoscope is very easily demonstrated, but it must be approached from another angle in chance events of the character we are dealing with.

I will later produce some examples which may serve as a guide for those who wish to pursue investigations along these lines. But the consideration of the Numerical power of the Midheaven itself, is a different proposition altogether and it is this aspect from which my friend claimed so many successes. I will demonstrate later.

HOW TO CALCULATE MAPS FOR RACING EVENTS

For systems other than Phonetic.

First you must procure an Ephemeris for the required year. An Ephemeris is a compilation of Astronomical data which can be easily obtained from any bookshop. Several good ones are issued annually, but I think the best for your purpose is Raphael's.

Take this publication for 1939 and open it for January (pages 2 and 3).

Take January 1st (about the middle of these pages), and we find it set out as follows:-

The first column is the date, the second, the initials of the day, the third, the important Sidereal Time. Next, the longitude, latitude and declination of the Moon (you will only need the longitude). Then comes the Moon midnight, which you can disregard, the longitude of the Planets followed by a tabulation of the Lunar Aspects (the relations of the Moon to the Heavenly Bodies).

Now, suppose we wish to find the Sidereal Time for 2.30 p.m. on Sunday, January 1st. 1939, we proceed in this simple way.



(Notice that by adding 40 to 30 minutes we have 70 minutes which is one hour ten minutes). So you carry over the hour. Now take your Ephemeris and turn to the end of the book, headed TABLES OF HOUSES FOR LONDON, Latitude 516 321.

Here is shown the degrees of the signs of the Zodiac from the 10th. House (which is the Midheaven) to the 3rd. House. There are 12 Houses or divisions in the Map. I will not ask you to regard any but those numbers under 10 (10th. House), which follow the Sidereal Time.

Taking the Sidereal column nearest to the time we have, equals 21.10.58. You will find this in the second middle column in the second half of the page.

Select 21 . 9 . 53.



Now you have your race map showing the important Midheaven (10th. House), which is the same all over the world.

Next, turn once again to pages 2 and 3 of your Ephemeris, to fill in the planets. You will notice that the Sun is 10°V 10'.55", which you can regard as 10.11 V). Set this in your map

just under V 15, in the 8th. House. I have placed arrows on each side of the map, and these will help you to know the positions of the planets.

Those degrees less than the number of degrees of the sign indicated, in this case 15, put towards the head of the arrow. If the degrees of the Sun were, say 20, we would put the Sun in the 9th. House; for the tail of the arrow shows that the greater should be placed above the 15, as the head showed the lesser to be placed below.

The Moon is shown to be 10.42 & (Taurus), so place the Moon a little above the 15, over the word Ascendant. Neptune is shown as 23.19 MR, (Virgo), so place Neptune above the 15 line (tail of the arrow), in the 5th. House. Uranus is 14.1 & (Taurus), just under the Moon in the Ascendant. Saturn is 11.31 (Aries), Jupiter, 0.32 (Pisces), Mars, 12.49 MV (Scorpio), Venus 27.38 MV (Scorpio).

Therefore place Mars below 15 and Venus above. Mercury is 17.31 × (Sagittarius), above the 15 in the 8th. House.

It will be needful to include in the map the point known as Fortuna \(\oplus \) (Moon's Elongation), as this is noted by some old astrologers in judging events in this study. First take the Ascendant which is shown as 15 Taurus and count

To this add the Moon, which is 10.42 (near enough to 11), in the sign Taurus which equals 1.10

We subtract the Sun from this result. The Sun is 10.10 V (Capricom). Capricorn equals 9.

 $\gamma = 0$ = 1 = 2 = 3 = 4 = 5 = 6 = 7 = 8 = 9 etc. In this example we cannot take 9 from 2, so we have to add 12 signs to our Moon Ascendant thus:-

Five signs from Aries = Aries, O. Taurus, 1. Gemini, 2. Cancer, 3. Leo, 4. Virgo, 5. Equals FORTUNA 15.32 MR (Virgo), which we place between Neptune and the line in the fifth House, because 15.32 is greater than MR. (Virgo) 15 and less than ** (Neptune) 23.19. If, instead of 5.15.32, the calculation had shown us 5.35.32, we would have just set down the 5 under the Degrees and carried 1 sign to the other 5 under the signs column (making it 6.5..32), because you cannot have more than 30 Degrees to a Sign, any more than you can have more than 60 minutes to an hour.

Fortuna is an old property sign and is symbolised as a cross within a circle \bigoplus .

All the foregoing will give you enough elementary Astrology to serve your purpose and later you may have the urge to study Astrological calculation more closely. It may be remarked that the time Sunday 2.30 p.m. is both the hour and the sub-division of Venus, (2.28 to 2.32).
